## SDG 16 TARGETS

- **Strengthen Governance and Decision-Making Transparency.** AzTU's governance is managed by the Scientific Council, which ensures transparent decision-making processes, strategic development, and accountability. This council, comprising various stakeholders including student representatives, exemplifies democratic governance and institutional transparency.
- **Empower Student Participation in University Governance.** AzTU recognizes and actively involves student organizations in governance. Through bodies such as the Student Youth Organization, the Student Scientific Society, and the Student Trade Union Committee, students contribute to decision-making, advocate for student rights, and support social initiatives.
- **Engage and Collaborate with Local and Government Stakeholders.** By engaging local enterprises and government bodies, AzTU aligns its educational strategies with market demands. This partnership-driven approach supports stakeholder involvement in student training, fostering local employment opportunities and strengthening ties with the public sector.
- **Commit to Anti-Corruption and Ethical Standards.** AzTU enforces strict anti-corruption policies as part of its ethical framework, prohibiting the exchange of undue benefits. These policies enhance integrity within the university, ensuring fairness in educational and administrative practices.
- **Promote Academic Freedom and Research Autonomy.** AzTU supports academic freedom across its eight faculties and 22 departments, enabling staff and students to pursue independent research. This freedom fosters innovation and encourages academic contributions that align with the needs of the industrial sector.
- **Ensure Public Involvement in Institutional Oversight.** Through mechanisms like the Public Council and the Council of Elders, AzTU facilitates public engagement in university governance. These councils promote transparency and allow local residents and civil society members to contribute to institutional decision-making.
- **Provide Financial Transparency and Accountability.** AzTU adheres to financial reporting requirements by submitting its financial data to national authorities, reinforcing financial accountability as a state-funded institution.

## SDG 16's Positive Impact on other SDGs

### SDG 1 – No Poverty:

Stable and safe environments allow schools to function effectively and ensure that students have uninterrupted access to education. Strong legal systems protect education rights and promote equal access for all groups, including girls and marginalized communities. SDG 16 ensures that learning environments are secure, inclusive, and supportive.

### SDG 5 – Gender Equality:

SDG 16 supports the enforcement of laws and policies that prevent gender-based violence, discrimination, and inequality. Effective justice systems, legal protection, and accountable institutions ensure women and girls can fully participate in social, political, and economic life. Strong institutions help create a society where gender equality can be achieved.

Peaceful and well-governed societies attract investment, support entrepreneurship, and promote fair labor practices. Reducing corruption and improving transparency creates a stable environment for businesses to grow and create jobs. SDG 16 strengthens economic systems by ensuring trust and accountability across institutions.

Fair legal systems and inclusive governance help protect the rights of minority and vulnerable groups. SDG 16 promotes equal access to justice, political participation, and public services, reducing social and economic inequalities. Strong institutions ensure that everyone benefits from development—not only privileged groups.

### **Current situation**

#### **1. Enhanced Digital Governance and Transparency**

AzTU continued its digital transformation strategy, implementing secure electronic systems for document management, decision tracking, and university-wide transparency. This transformation aims to minimize bureaucratic delays, prevent corruption, and enhance accountability.
